Deeley was the Vice President of Administration, Operations and Planning at University of Miami School of Medicine, where he oversaw finance, operations and practice plan functions. He was responsible for the planning and financing of two campus research buildings, assessing a trustee supported healthcare merger proposal in South Florida, and leading the development of a regional medical school campus in Boca Raton. Deeley also served as the Executive Dean for Biology and Medicine at Brown University's Division of Biology and Medicine, and was responsible for finance, administration and strategic planning, as well as the financing and planning of a new medical school building adjacent to Brown's major teaching hospital.

Most recently, Deeley comes to Attain from Howard University College of Medicine, where he was Associate Dean of Resource Management responsible for leading the financial, administrative and operational functions of the College of Medicine.
